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There are other detailed rules for garbage disposal.

For example: Items over 50cm long are considered “bulky waste” and must be scheduled for collection. Some appliances, such as washing machines and refrigerators, have special disposal methods.

Rules on How to Dispose of Garbage in Kasukabe City



In Japan, there are rules on how to dispose of household garbage.

Failing to follow the rules will result in your garbage not being collected.

When that happens, bad odors may occur, and the garbage collection area can become dirty, causing an unpleasant environment for your neighbors.

If you live in an apartment complex, you may also receive a warning from the property management company.

In some cases, garbage that violates the rules may be returned to the home that put it out.

- If you continue to ignore the rules, you may be regarded as a problem resident, and
- your apartment or housing contract could even be terminated.
- Let's follow the rules and enjoy a comfortable life together.

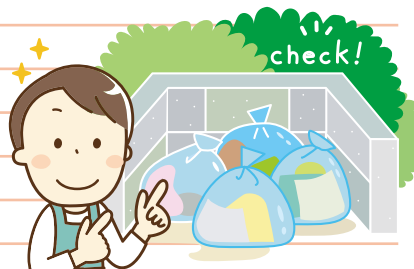

① Garbage disposal locations are designated

Dispose of your household garbage only at the designated location.

If you don't, it will not be collected.

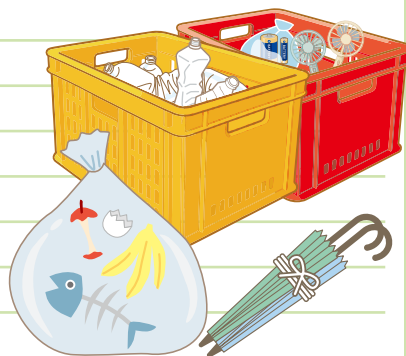
Please be sure to confirm the "Designated Location" with your landlord or real estate agent when you move in.



② Separate your garbage properly

Please separate your garbage into the following categories:

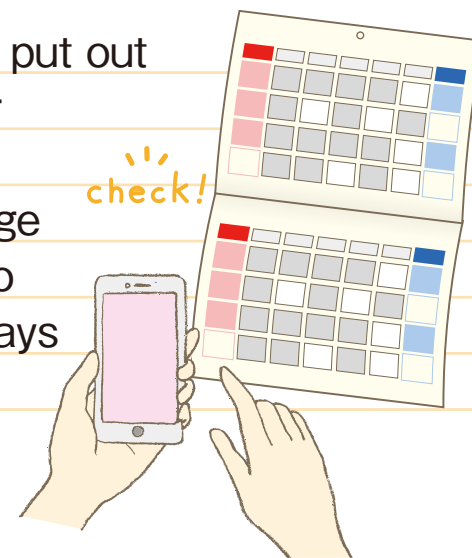
Burnable garbage, Non-burnable garbage, Bottles, cans, and PET bottles, Hazardous or dangerous waste, Paper and cloth. Do not discard mixed items together. You can check detailed separation rules on the garbage sorting app or website.



③ Garbage collection days are fixed

The days when you can put out separated garbage differ depending on your area.

Please check the garbage sorting app or website to find out the collection days in your neighborhood.



④ Put out your garbage by 8:00 a.m.

Garbage collection begins at 8:00 a.m.

If you put it out after collection, it will not be picked up.

Do not put garbage out the night before, as crows and other animals may scatter the contents.
